LMRL AA Program Resource Allocation Policy

Objective

The objective of the LMRL AA Program is to develop the strongest possible teams to represent LMRL at the Provincial AA Championships and to represent the province of BC at the Canadian Ringette Championships and the Western Canadian Ringette Championships. To fulfill this objective, the scarce resources available to the AA program must be allocated carefully and efficiently. The objective of this policy is to provide a general framework to guide the allocation of resources including but not limited to items such as practice and game ice, equipment and attire, funding, sponsorship proceeds, tryout and registration fees.

Policy Description

The primary annual objective of the LMRL AA Program is to field the strongest possible teams at the Canadian Ringette Championships. A similar but lesser objective is to field the strongest possible team at the Western Canadian Ringette Championships. As such, resources available generally to the LMRL AA Program shall be allocated according to the priorities indicated in the following table.

Priority	Description	Qualifying Teams
1	Teams eligible to participate in the Canadian Ringette Championships (CRC)	Junior AA, Belle AA, Open AA
2	Teams eligible to participate in the Western Canadian Ringette Championship (WCRC)	Tween AA
3	Development teams whose players are eligible for call-up to CRC-eligible teams	Junior AA Development
4	Development teams whose players are eligible for call-up to WCRC-eligible teams	Tween AA Development
5	All other Development teams	Petite AA Development
